Dear Best Classes Ever, Partners, and Friends,

Leadership Lancaster kicked off our 40th anniversary in January 2023, but the celebrations and excitement were there for the entire 2022-2023 program year! If last year is any indication, more excitement is ahead!

We expanded programming options so more of Lancaster County has equitable access to training that connects, educates, and inspires community leadership. This Spring, 110 leaders across five programs graduated in front of friends, family, and LL alumni:

- 78 existing and emerging community leaders participated in the 2023 Core Class
- A cohort of Swahili speakers (including Moses, our first infant graduate) participated in the innagural nine-week New Americans Leadership Academy for members of our refugee and immigrant communities in partnership with Church World Service and the Lancaster Lebanon IU 13
- The College Core Class, created to inspire the future leaders of our community and offered in partnership with the Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology, grew to include an additional cohort at Millersville University
- Leaders new to Lancaster or new to their executive role completed the six-week Executive Class, strenthening their connections with each other and other community leaders while deepening their understanding of our County
- And of course, we continue to support the development and sustainability of our nonprofit community with Leadership Advantage and Board trainings

Not only that, but our partnership with the City of Lancaster continued with the Neighborhood Leaders Academy, we partnered with Franklin and Marshall College and the Diplomat Leadership Program to connect student leaders with Lancaster County, and our volunteer committee has just selected another 80 community leaders for the upcoming 2024 Core Class! The future is bright!

None of this would have been possible without our alumni, community partners, volunteers, and program facilitators. Thank you for your commitment to transforming Lancaster County with connected, educated, and INSPIRED leaders!
